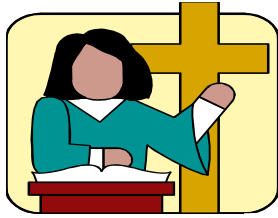

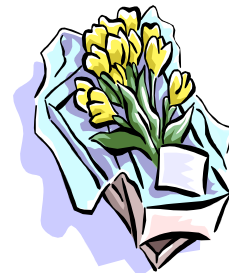

Thanks to Valerie Smith for the yard sale she organized on July 11th...

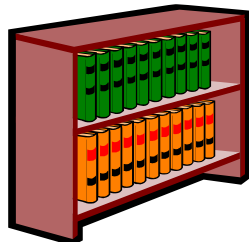
